1. All race boats must be parked in the SBIP designated Dry Pits during daylight hours (8am to 7pm) starting on Friday, August 3th, 2018 until after the race on Sunday, August 5th, 2018.
 2. If a team is displaying their race boat at a business off site, a certificate of liability is required to be issued to Super Boat International Productions Inc. from the establishment in the amount of one million dollars.

- RACE COURSE** 4.2 Mile Lap - Lake Michigan

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REGISTRATION CONT.

2. When you arrive on site, check in with registration to get your paperwork completed.
 - Pre-Race Technical Inspection
 - Rescue / Safety Pre –Race Review
 - Registration forms

Any race team that has a person in the race boat during the race event (August 3 - 5, 2018) that is not a 2018 Racing Member, and has not completed registration will be DISQUALIFIED.

3. The OWNER OF EQUIPMENT Is responsible for:
 - All Registration forms completed.
 - All riding crew members are a minimum of 18 years of age.
 - Report any change of racing crew in the boat prior to LAUNCHING, TESTING, OR RACING.

DRONES

Race pit area, crane area and race course is a **NO DRONE ZONE**

AIRCRAFT REGISTRATION / PRIVATE MEDICAL HELICOPTER

It is an FAA requirement that all aircraft flying the race course must contact the SBIP office at 305-296-6166 to obtain the proper forms. You will need to provide the aircraft registrations numbers and certificate of insurance listing Super Boat International Productions, Inc. as additional insured. This information needs to be received thirty (30) days prior to the event. SBIP will notify aircraft if authorization is granted to fly the event. Any aircraft flying for a team at an event that does not have authorization from SBIP to fly, the team will receive a DISQUALIFICATION, and a \$2,500.00 (two thousand, five hundred dollar) fine and will not be permitted to have an aircraft fly again for that team.

RACE TEAM / PRIVATE MEDICAL HELICOPTER: RACE TEAM /

Race teams that want to have additional Rescue person (s) flying for their team, must notify the SBIP main office at 305-296-6166 thirty (30) days prior to the event. SBIP will assign the Rescue Diver from our rescue staff to fly in the helicopter

for the event. The Race Team is responsible for payment of the helicopter (minimum jet ranger), lodging, travel, and cost of the Rescue Diver. The helicopter would be under the direction of SBIP's Medical Director for the event. Cost of the Rescue Diver would be paid in advance by the race team to SBIP. SBIP will no longer accept or approve a team to deploy a rescue diver that has not been assigned by the SBIP Rescue Staff to be qualified to go into the team's helicopter as a rescue diver, with dive gear. Any aircraft flying for a team at an event must have authorization from SBIP to fly. If a team has aircraft flying an event that does not have authorization from SBIP, the team will receive a fine of \$2,500.00 (two thousand, five hundred dollars), a **DISQUALIFICATION**, and will not be permitted to have an aircraft fly again for that team.

OFFICIAL WATERCRAFT

If a race team wants to have an official watercraft for the race, it has to sign up with SBIP and follow the Official Guidelines for that duty. Any Official Watercraft that is signed up for the race is under the direction of the SBIP Race Control. The Official Watercraft must remain at their station until the end of the race and is dismissed by the SBIP Race Control. Official Watercraft that sign up as a patrol boat is not a tow boat for the team, if the team wants them to be as a tow boat, they would have to be in the spectator area of the race course and the Official Tow boat company for the race would have to tow the race vessel to that area. If a race team's vessel should need assistance they have to call the SBIP Race Control to report the assistance needed.

MEMBERSHIPS

All persons working with the boat **MUST** be a 2018 Racing Member of SBIP

- Cost of SBIP Membership - \$350.00
- The Membership card will be your ID for the season.
- Members are required to sign an insurance waiver at every race event and check in at registration upon arrival to the site to obtain an arm band.
- Minimum Age Restrictions for Racing Members

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MEMBERSHIPS CONT:

- a. The minimum age for a Racing Member to compete in a race boat shall be 18.
- b. The minimum age for a Racing Member to enter into the restricted area of the hot pits shall be 16.
- c. The minimum age for a Racing Member to enter into the dry pit area only shall be 5. This does not allow them to drive any motorized vehicles (golf carts, skateboards, mopeds, etc.), or enter into the restricted area of the hot pits.

Three (3) boats in a class will receive prize money from 3rd place to 5th place.
Two (2) boats in a class will receive prize money from 4th place to 5th place.
One (1) boat in a class will receive prize money for 5th place.

Any Class with eight (8) or more Boats starting (crossing the start line) will receive an extra \$1,000.00 (40%-25%-20%-10%-5%) added to the Prize Purse for that Class. (Example) A Class with \$8,500.00 listed prize purse, and they have eight (8) Boats in their Class, the Prize Purse for that Class will be increased to \$9,500.00.
